Annex 4 - Excuse Sharing Your Mahara Site

When you have completed your Mahara portfolio and would like to show it to your teacher, parents or even grant access to a potential employer, you have different options to edit the access to your Mahara ePortfolio.

You can permit access to Mahara users or user with no Mahara account without making your work publicly available and searchable by search engines.

For the latter, you create a secret URL, copy this URL and paste it into an e-mail to send to somebody, e.g. you teacher or your potential employer.

You can also add a time restriction for access to your page via this URL. Please follow the step-by-step guide to learn how to provide access to your ePortfolio with a secret
